Discover Finnish Higher Education

Finnish universities and polytechnics are committed to maintaining high standards in their education. This applies to both teaching and research as well as student services. Finland's good reputation in higher education combined with the wide range of courses offered in English attract interest among an increasing number of international students. With this guidebook we wish to encourage you and all international students to add a Finnish flavour to your education.

This brochure provides a list of international study programmes developed by Finnish institutions of higher education. The range of programmes offered is very diverse. Programmes of only a couple of weeks and several years are both included. Some of the programmes are short courses which usually can only be taken as part of an exchange programme (in this brochure they are referred to as "other programmes" – however, courses of less than five Finnish credits are not included in the list). Degree programmes are broader-based, take several years to complete and lead to a recognised qualification. In most of the programmes the language of instruction is English.

The programmes presented in this list do not cover all the options. There are many institutions, faculties and departments which offer tailor-made curricula for international students – this especially applies to doctoral level studies. The choice is yours.

We hope you will find the information in this brochure helpful. If you need more detailed information on higher education in Finland, contact us, the Centre for International Mobility CIMO. CIMO is a specialist service organisation working under the Finnish Ministry of Education. It enhances international co-operation by co-ordinating and implementing a range of exchange and scholarship programmes as well as supporting internationalisation through the provision of communication and information services.

Introduction

The Finnish education system

The Finnish education system consists of pre-school education, comprehensive school, post-comprehensive general and vocational education, higher education and adult education. Comprehensive school provides a nine-year educational programme (with a voluntary 10th form) for all school-age children, beginning at the age of seven. Post-comprehensive education is given by general upper secondary schools (approx. three years, ending in the national matriculation examination) and vocational institutions (three years, leading to upper secondary vocational qualifications).

Higher education is provided by 20 universities (*yliopisto/universitet* in Finnish/Swedish) and 29 polytechnics (*ammattikorkeakoulut/yrkeshögskolor*, for short AMK/YH). Adult education is given by special institutions, vocational institutions (specifically by vocational adult education centres), polytechnics, and universities, all of which have a continuing education centre.

Universities

Finnish universities have roots going back to the 17th century and today the country has one of the most comprehensive university networks in Europe. There are 20 universities in Finland: of these ten are multi-faculty universities, three are universities of technology, three are schools of economics and business administration, and the remaining four are art academies. In addition, university-level education is provided at the National Defence College under the Ministry of Defence.

The total university enrolment is currently 163,000 students, of which approx. 3,700 are students from abroad studying for a de-

gree. The number of international visiting students at the Finnish universities is approx. 3,500 per year.

All universities carry out research and confer doctorates.

System of study

Finnish university degrees correspond to Bachelor's (*kandidaatti/kandidat*), Master's (*maisteri/magister*) and Doctor's degrees (*tohtori/doktor*). In most fields students can also take a Licentiate's degree (*lisensiaatti/licentiat*) before the Doctor's degree.

The Bachelor's degree takes at least three years to complete. It consists of basic and intermediate studies in the major subject, including a Bachelor's thesis, studies in one or more minor subjects and language studies. The Master's degree requires at least five years of full-time study (or two years after a Bachelor's degree) and includes advanced studies and a Master's thesis.

University study consists of several types of work: lectures and other instruction, exercises, essays or other independent work, set-book examinations, seminars, and so on. They can be compulsory or optional. It is possible to take extra courses in addition to what is required for the degree. Students increasingly do part of their studies at other universities in Finland or abroad.

It should be possible to complete a Licentiate's degree in two years and a Doctor's degree in four. Research and the preparation of a substantial thesis are essential parts of the studies for both the Licentiate's and Doctor's degrees.

The unit by which study progress is measured is the credit (*opintoviikko/studievecka*). One credit is awarded for approximately 40 hours of work. One semester of full-time study is usually worth 15–20 credits. The minimum requirement for a Bachelor's degree is 120

credits. The Master's degree requires 160–180 credits.

Continuing education centres at the universities provide professional education for university graduates as well as organise open university instruction. Polytechnics

The Finnish polytechnic system was built during the 1990's to create a non-university sector of higher education. It is founded on the institutions which previously provided post-secondary vocational education and which have been developed to form a nationwide network of regional institutions of higher education, i.e. polytechnics.

Polytechnic education emphasises close contacts with business, industry and services, especially at the regional level. The degrees are designed to meet the changing requirements and development needs of the world of work, having a pronounced occupational emphasis, and qualifying graduates for various expert duties. Polytechnics undertake some research and development with an applied and practical emphasis.

There are 29 polytechnics, most of which are multi-field and operate in several units. Currently there are approx. 121,000 students registered at polytechnics in Finland. Around 2,600 of them are students from abroad studying for a degree. There are approx. 2,000 international visiting students at the Finnish polytechnics per year.

Polytechnic-level education is also provided at the Police College, which operates under the Ministry of the Interior.

System of study

Polytechnic degrees are Bachelor-level higher education degrees with a professional emphasis. Studies are organised into degree programmes, which are confirmed by the Ministry of Education. However, the curricula are independently decided by the polytechnics. The extent of a degree programme is measured in credits. The term "credit" refers to approx. 40 hours of work. The study load for an academic year is around 40 credits. The extent of most degree programmes is either 140 or 160 credits, which corresponds to three and a half or four years of full-time study; an extension of one year is allowed.

Degree programmes consist of basic and professional studies, optional studies, practical studies including an on-the-job training period, and a Bachelor's thesis. The studies also include communication and language studies, i.e. studies in the native language, in the second official language and in one or more foreign languages. Students can also combine studies in other fields, other institutions, or abroad, with their degree.

How to apply?

Visiting students

Exchange students can come to Finland through European Union programmes, such as Socrates/Erasmus and Leonardo da Vinci. Students from the USA may participate in the ISEP exchange programme while students from the other Nordic countries can take advantage of the Nordplus scheme. Finnish institutions of higher education have bilateral agreements with colleges and universities abroad which also cover exchange programmes. In special cases, students can be accepted from outside the above schemes.

Degree students

As a general rule, international applicants for degree studies in Finland must first meet the minimum requirements of their own country for entry into higher education. They must also be prepared to come to Finland to take an entrance test, especially when applying for entry to universities. For the degree programmes listed in this brochure, good command of English must usually be certified. In other degree studies a good knowledge of Finnish or Swedish is in most cases compulsory. Further information about application and entrance requirements is best obtained directly from the university or polytechnic.

Post-graduate students

Post-graduates from other countries are admitted to all Finnish universities. Students are advised to directly contact the university in which they are interested.

Further general information

Languages

Instruction and coursework is mainly carried out in Finnish or Swedish, depending on the educational institution. International students staying for shorter periods, however, mostly communicate and work in English, although they are encouraged to participate in Finnish or Swedish language programmes designed for international students.

In most of the programmes of this list the language of instruction is English. Universities usually have a Language Centre where students may carry out additional language studies, which are often included in degree programmes.

Semesters and vacations

The academic year has two semesters. The autumn semester generally runs from September (in polytechnics also from August) to

December, and the spring semester from January to May. There is no summer semester, but university students can take examinations and study for their degrees in the summer months in courses arranged either by the universities themselves or by the Summer University system (21 in all).

Costs

Since university education is funded by the State through the Ministry of Education, students enrolled in regular degree studies pay no tuition fees. The student unions, however, charge an annual membership fee of about EUR 40–85 to cover their activities. Student health services are included in this fee. Membership is compulsory for those who are studying for their Bachelor's or Master's degree; those who are pursuing their doctoral studies may join the union if they wish.

Polytechnics do not charge tuition fees either, but a few institutions currently charge fees for tuition materials, etc. Student union membership for students in polytechnics is optional.

Students in both universities and polytechnics have to pay for their books and other materials, plus their accommodation and living expenses. The total monthly living expenses of a single student average around EUR 690.

The degree programmes presented in this list usually carry no tuition fees. However, some of the other programmes may be subject to a fee. Please contact the institution or visit Discover Finland website at <http://finland.cimo.fi> (Studying | International Programmes) to check the fees.

Financial aid

Foreign students who are accepted into Finnish degree studies may obtain study aid from the Finnish government if they have lived in Finland for at least two years for some other

purpose than studies, and their residence in Finland is considered to be permanent. Returning immigrants and refugees are exempt from this regulation. The citizens of EU and other EEA countries may apply for study aid if their studies are closely related to their work in Finland, if they have become involuntarily unemployed in Finland, or if their parents are working in Finland.

The Centre for International Mobility CIMO and some other organisations grant some scholarships for advanced studies and research in Finland. Some of the grants are limited to students from specific countries or fields of study. There are also grants available without these conditions and institutions may apply for them on behalf of the advanced students and researchers they have accepted. Additional information is available from CIMO, Finnish embassies and the appropriate authorities (in most countries the Ministry of Education) of student's own country.

Other benefits and services

Student housing is generally organised by established student housing foundations. In some university towns accommodation can also be arranged through the student unions themselves, or through regional student clubs or faculty organisations. Many towns and municipalities also have dormitories maintained by the municipal community or the educational institution. Contact the international advisory service of your chosen educational institution in Finland for more infor-

mation. The receiving institution usually takes care of the accommodation of exchange students.

Student union membership entitles the student to a number of benefits: health services, subsidised meals, cheap travel options and other discounts.

The universities and polytechnics offer many kinds of information and other services. These include advisory services for international students, student libraries, computer classes, access to the Internet and sports facilities.
